



## Rainbows Bereavement or Separation Loss Programme Registration.

## Shannon Family Resource Centre is a registered Rainbows Centre.

We support trained volunteers to facilitate the 10-week Rainbows Peer Support groups for young people in the Shannon region who have either experienced a **Bereavement** or **Parental separation** in their life.

## We want to provide Rainbows to young people in the Shannon area annually.

Level 4: Secondary aged 13-16 years (1st year to TY)	Level 4: Secondary aged 13-16 years (1st year to TY)
Each programme runs for 10 weeks 1 hour per week after school.	

**Recruitment information:** We offer the programme to between 6-8 young people of similar age/level. Levels 1-3 are primary school age and level 4 is for young people aged 12-15 years, up to transition year in secondary school.

- Only one member of a family allowed per group.
- The programme is 10 weeks long, 1 hour per week.
- The young person must have experienced either Separation/Divorce or a Death in the family to be eligible to participate in the programme.

Signed consent from both parents or legal guardians is required for the separation programme if previously married, this is Rainbows Ireland policy.
